

### Checklist at initial submission:

- A cover letter describing the novelty of your work (mandatory).
- ORCID ID for all authors in the manuscript body text.**
- All figures are in colour. Please find details on figure requirements: [journalallergy.com](http://journalallergy.com)
- Author affiliations are up-to-date. Incomplete affiliations may affect your future grant applications.
- Funding source and grant number are included. Lack of this information might result in difficulties seeking future research grants based on your work.
- Order of files: Cover letter, manuscript text (with line numbers), original figures, supplementary text, supplementary figures (supplementary text and figures can be submitted in a single pdf file)

### Checklist at revision stage:

- Conflict of interest statement is included in the body text of the manuscript. If there are no conflicts of interest, please write “The authors declare no conflict of interest in relation to this work”, or similar.

**Example: (author Initials RMA)** reports grants from xxxx,Germany, Jupiter Science Foundation; XXXXXXCenter for Allergy Research and Education; European Commission Horizon 2020 Framework Programme; XXXXXX, XXXX Research Institute, Country; Research Grants from Company Name, Country; Speakers Bureau, Company name, Country; Shares, Company name, Country. All other authors have no conflict of interest within the scope of the submitted work.

- Cover letter
- Point-by-point reply to reviewers’ comments. Explain major changes in the first page and also if there is any changes in figures.
- Revised manuscript (clean)
